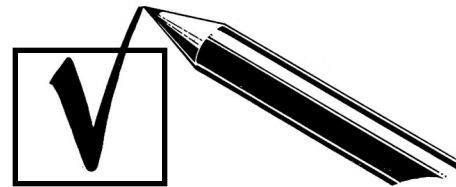


If the High Street Hill Association wasn't here, who would... ?
